Thought for Today

In today's Gospel reading we have two stories for the price of one as we often find in Mark who "sandwiches" one story inside another in a skilful way to emphasise his message.

The stories work by means of both similarities and differences. Healing is urgently needed for two people in desperate situations but in one case the approach to Jesus has to be done stealthily because the woman was regarded as unclean and an outcast from society whereas Jairus' daughter was part of a respected family but Jesus shows compassion for both.

In both cases risk was involved: the woman risked making anyone she came into contact with unclean, Jairus risked his reputation as a synagogue leader as Jesus has just been cast out of the synagogue and was no longer acceptable to the authorities and Jesus himself faced the risk of being an increasing threat to the religious authorities.

Faith is important in the woman's healing and this emphasises the realisation that healing isn't always just physical but a matter of how we think and what we believe, of both body and spirit.

Above all we are invited to reflect on Jesus' readiness to cross boundaries of various kinds and on whether there are any we reject as unclean or unworthy of our care.
