Today we think about the joy we can experience in everyday life. Our Old Testament reading from 2 Samuel 6 is about David's joy as he dances and sings, accompanying the Covenant Box into Jerusalem. Our New Testament reading from Luke reminds us of the Joy of the Holy Spirit. I have recently returned from a trip to Malawi, in South East Africa. I was there as a trustee of MACS (Malawi Association of Christian Support) where I spent time visiting people living in rural villages, seeing the impact of the installation of water pumps, solar to generate electricity and school classrooms. At the 9.30 service I will be sharing the joy these simple improvements give to the community.

Thought for Today for 8.00am Holy Communion (Mark 6:14-29)

The Gospel reading at 8 a.m. is Mark 6:14-29, recounting the story of the death of John the Baptist. It's not a cheery story! John the Baptist's condemnation of Herod's marriage to Herodias was a bold act of truth-telling, which came at the ultimate cost. Herod is depicted as a complex character who respects John as a righteous and holy man, yet is also deeply troubled by him. His promise to Herodias' daughter, made in a moment of pride and without consideration, leads to John's death. Through this story we gain insights into personal integrity, the complexity of human emotions, and the tragic reality that good people sometimes have to pay a high price for their stand.

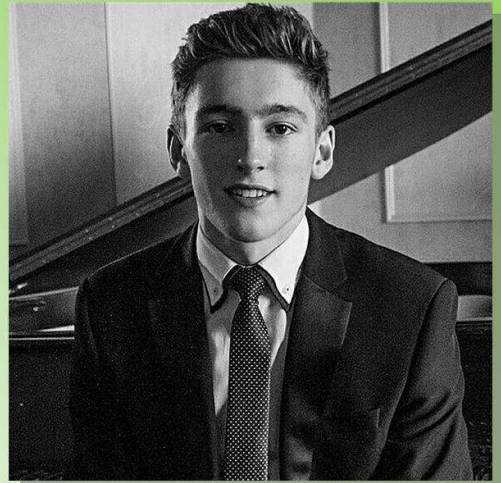
