### **Thought for Today**

For the third week in a row, we continue with our Gospel readings from John 6, in which we find Jesus discussing the theme of "living bread". His listeners are still as confused as they ever were: what Jesus is saying sounds nonsensical, even offensive, to them. But Jesus continues to develop his theme, touching again on his main points: he is the living bread, the bread that he gives is his body, this bread will bring life to those who receive it. As we hear Jesus's words today, perhaps we also find them difficult to understand or accept. Are we able to sit with our discomfort, and with what we don't yet understand, long enough to let him speak to us afresh?




