### **Thought for Today**

This week we come to the end of the liturgical year with the celebration of Christ the King. It has been said that the phrase "Jesus is Lord" is the earliest and shortest of the church's creeds, summing up in just two words (in the Greek) the Gospel the first Christians believed, proclaimed, and tried to live by. "My kingdom is not from this world," says Jesus in this Sunday's Gospel reading, emphasizing that his reign is radically different from that of earthly rulers. Its origins are not in human power or popularity but in God's will. And his followers are to spread the influence of this kingdom not by the sword, but by continuing the work Jesus started: proclaiming, healing, teaching, helping, feeding and rescuing. This means that our celebration today is also a call to action. How can we show that Jesus is King in Gosforth today?


